If you think you might be pregnant, a good first step is to schedule a medical pregnancy test with a trusted health care provider, like Piedmont Women's Center.

Symptoms such as a missed period do not always result from pregnancy.

Clients in the early stages of pregnancy may be eligible for a free, limited OB ultrasound at Piedmont Women's Center. By definition, a limited OB ultrasound establishes whether a pregnancy is viable, by identifying a heartbeat; determines that the pregnancy is intrauterine, or in the uterus; and measures the gestational age of the baby.

A limited OB ultrasound is a valuable tool in your decision-making process.

Regardless of the anxiety you may be experiencing now, a pregnancy is not the end of your prospects. Many women have been in your place and have gone on to complete degrees and accomplish great things in their careers.

If you are pregnant you have three options; parenting, adoption and abortion.
