If you think you might be pregnant, a good first step is to schedule a medical pregnancy test with a trusted health care provider, like Piedmont Women's Center. Symptoms such as a missed period do not always result from pregnancy. **It is important to start by scheduling an appointment to get a medical-grade proof of pregnancy.** After receiving a positive or negative pregnancy confirmation you can determine your next steps.

A limited OB ultrasound is a valuable tool in your decision-making process.

After receiving a positive proof of pregnancy, a limited OB ultrasound can help provide you with the answers you need. The purpose of a limited OB ultrasound is to determine the location of the pregnancy, gestational age, and fetal heartbeat.

If you are pregnant you have three options; parenting, adoption or abortion. You can find more information on our website or you can make an appointment with us to discuss your individual circumstances.

Parenting Assistance If you are considering parenting, help is available. We can help you find resources for nutrition, education, professional counseling, housing, and more. We are here to help you understand all the assistance available to you.

Abortion Abortion is a medical (the abortion pill) or surgical procedure that terminates pregnancy. Piedmont Women's Center does not perform or refer for abortion.
